



The tax cap for 2016 is less than 1%. The Tentative Budget will be reviewed by the Town Board during meetings on September 3rd and 24th with a special meeting scheduled if needed.

I would like to thank Jackie Van Lare, Kevin Weiss, Linda Kleeman, Mike Buckley, Ron Foreman, and Dave Barmaster for their hard work and vision to continually improve the market for the residents, visitors, and vendors. Our solar array project is under way to the west of Lorraine Drive. After the installation of the array, the actual "powering up" will be done by Rochester Gas & Electric sometime in November or December.

Medical Loan Closet

The Town of Walworth Medical Loan Closet can assist you in your time of need. Our Medical Loan Closet contains a variety of durable medical equipment including but not limited to: Wheelchairs, crutches, bedpans, portable commodes, and more. The Walworth Town Clerk's Office is happy to assist you with the borrowing of these items. Please call for item availability. Items may also be delivered if necessary.

Walworth Food Pantry

Residents who wish to donate goods to the Walworth Food Pantry may do so at the Walworth Town Hall during regular business hours. The following items are in need throughout the year: Cereal, canned fruit, Jell-O, pudding, soup, crackers, canned meats, canned potatoes, rice, jelly, canned vegetables, macaroni, spaghetti sauce, peanut butter, baked beans, coffee, tea bags, and sugar. Other non-food items are also in great need throughout the year. Personal and household items such as bar soap, dish soap, laundry detergent, and bathroom tissue may also be donated.

While we are sad that there are only a few more weeks left of summer, we are very excited about what's to come in the Fall!

The Town Clerk's office is considered the center of town government. The Town Clerk serves residents directly through the issuance of licenses (dog, marriage, hunting, fishing, games of chance, handicap parking, bingo, and raffles among others). As Registrar of Vital Statistic's I issue and maintain all birth and death certificates in the Town as well as processing genealogy applications. In addition, the Town Clerk serves the Town Board as the recording secretary of Town Board meetings (preparing and maintaining the minutes). Other services include:

Hunting Licenses - The office will be open Sunday, November 1st from 7:00am-12:00pm to issue the NYS DEC DMP's - lottery.

Notary Service - This free service is available - you must appear in person and bring proof of identity to have a document notarized. Visits are available for shut-ins. This service is confidential.

Sunshine List - Stay connected to the Town by email! Send an email to twncldr@townofwalworthny.gov to be added to the list and receive a courtesy email with meeting minutes, notices, and more!

Forms Online - Many of our forms are now available for download at our webpage www.townofwalworthny.gov.

Serving you as Town Clerk since 2006, my goal is to make the Town Clerk's office even more accessible to our residents and keeping you connected with your local government. You are invited to visit our office located at the Walworth Town Hall upper level. There you will find courteous staff ready to assist you to obtain the services that you require. FROM THE BUILDING DEPT.

With the Fall and Winter months just around the corner many residents will turn to their wood stoves and fireplaces to provide some much needed warmth! Here are some important reminders to ensure the safe operation of these heat sources:

- Prior to starting your wood stove or fireplace, have a chimney sweep clean and inspect it. You may have had a chimney fire and not even been aware of it (if the flue is damaged it may be covered under your home-owner's policy)!
- Be aware of the type of wood your are purchasing. There are many reputable wood suppliers, but there are also those who sell green and/or soft wood at the same price as good, seasoned hard woods. Green and soft woods are hard to burn and may also lead to a build-up of creosote.
- Storage of wood is also important. If it is to be stored outside it should be covered and kept dry. Wet and frozen wood is hard to burn and may also lead to build-up of creosote.
- A good practice to prevent creosote build-up: After running the stove on low overnight, run it hot in the morning for 10 to 15 minutes. If you have a thermometer on the stovepipe, get it to between 400 and 500 degrees. Do this daily. This will generally crystallize the creosote so it falls back into the stove. To be sure of safe operation, have the chimney cleaned periodically as well.

Finally, a reminder that building permits are required for wood stoves, chimneys, fireplaces (gas or wood), replacement furnaces, and chimney re-lining. New York State Code requires that prior to the relining of a chimney, it be cleaned as well as inspected. Stand-by generators and transfer switches also require a building permit and have to be inspected by the town as well as an electrical inspector.

Volunteers & Instructors



From time to time staff members may photograph our program and event participants. We do not use any identification when publishing photos. If you wish to not have any photos published or appear on social media please let us know.




The Lodge

Ginegaw & Sherburne Road PAVILIONS

Alongside the Lodge both the Ginegaw Park and Sherburne Road Park Pavilions offer attractive seasonal (April 1st - October 1st) rental options for parties and events. Each pavilion features seating for up to 80 guests, lights and electricity, outdoor charcoal grills, seamless playground and playing field access, and portable toilets.

GINEGAW PARK PAVILION

Located a stones throw from the Lodge, the Ginegaw Park Pavilion sits adjacent to the park's main playground and remains a favorite rental option for those with children. Other additional amenities include horseshoe pits, nearby access to the Ginegaw Park Hiking Trail, and sewer tied bathrooms within walking distance of the facility.

SHERBURNE ROAD PAVILION

Nestled in the rear of Sherburne Park, Sherburne Road Pavilion offers a unique sense of privacy while still providing top notch rental amenities like our nature themed playground, the popular Red Trail Hiking Loop, playing field access, and more.

RESIDENT RENTAL STATUS

Property taxes must be paid to the Town of Walworth to be considered a resident and be awarded residential rental fees. All other potential renters who do not pay their property taxes to the Town of Walworth are considered non-residents. All facilities are reserved on a first come, first serve basis. Full rental payment is due at the time of reservation. Outdoor pavilion rentals span dawn to dusk. Lodge reservations entitle patrons access to facility from 9:00am-10:00pm on the day of the facility rental.



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

PRESCHOOL (TOT DECK)

Designed for children 3 to 5 years of age but will depend on the child's water experience. Participants will be in water 18" deep and taken out on the "tot deck" by the instructor and instructor aides.

LEVEL #1: WATER EXPLORATION

Designed for the beginning swimmer to feel comfortable in and to enjoy the water safely. Fundamental water safety and skills focusing on fun is emphasized. This group will work on putting their faces in the water, floating on front or back, or holding their breath under water and beginning movement in water.

LEVEL #2: PRIMARY SKILLS






