

**T**hank you to everyone who attended the Festival in the Park on July 25 & 26, 2014. I hope you enjoyed the parade, movie, fireworks and activities that were held in the park.

The 2015 budget process has begun with Department Heads submitting their proposed budgets to me. The Town Comptroller, Jean Johnson and I will be working on the preliminary budget to submit to the Town Board. The Town Board will be reviewing the requests as part of our Town Board meetings in September. The Preliminary Budget will be turned into the Town Clerk's Office by the required deadline of September 30th. A public hearing on the Preliminary Budget will be held in October and the Final 2015 budget will be adopted by the Town Board in November.

The proposed changes to the lake levels of Lake Ontario have been reviewed and the impacts associated with the proposed IJC's PLAN2014 to this area are substantial. The proposed lake levels will not only impact the south shoreline of Lake Ontario, but will impact all of the area Towns with reduction in tourism opportunities, possible flooding of homes and businesses based on current lake levels and significant financial impact to all of us. The County Board of Supervisors is continuing to work with our State representatives to voice our opposition with PLAN2014.

Town Clerk Susie Jacobs has appointed a new Deputy Town Clerk, Christi Waltermyer in her office. Christi previously was working as a clerk in the Town Clerk's Office. She is beginning her training to learn the added responsibilities as Deputy Town Clerk.

The Ginegaw Farmers Market has been a wonderful opportunity for our community to support the area farmers. The Parks and Recreation Department has done a wonderful job in looking for a variety of vendors and exhibits to showcase for the community. While the Ginegaw Farmers Market has faced some weather challenges this year, we have heard many positive comments about the great opportunity that is being provided.

I and the Town Board would like to take this opportunity to apologize for any inconvenience that you may have encountered recently with the Town Clerk's Office being closed periodically. It is the Town Board's goal for all of the offices to be available during the Town's published office hours.

Enjoy the last few weeks of summer and have a safe and happy Labor Day.

The Town of Walworth Medical Loan Closet can assist you in your time of need. Our Medical Loan Closet contains a variety of durable medical equipment including but not limited to: Wheelchairs, crutches, bedpans, portable commodes, and more. The Walworth Town Clerk's Office is happy to assist you with the borrowing of these items. Please call for item availability. Items may also be delivered if necessary.

### Walworth Food Pantry

Residents who wish to donate goods to the Walworth Food Pantry may do so at the Walworth Town Hall during regular business hours. The following items are in need throughout the year: Cereal, canned fruit, Jell-O, pudding, soup, crackers, canned meats, canned potatoes, rice, jelly, canned vegetables, macaroni, spaghetti sauce, peanut butter, baked beans, coffee, tea bags, and sugar. Other non-food items are also in great need throughout the year. Personal and household items such as bar soap, dish soap, laundry detergent, and bathroom tissue may also be donated.

**W**hile we are sad that there are only a few more weeks left of summer, we are very excited about what's to come in Fall.

The town clerk's office is considered the center of town government. The town clerk serves residents directly through the issuance of licenses (dog, marriage, hunting and fishing, games of chance, handicap parking, bingo and raffles). As Registrar of Vital Statistic's I issue and maintain all birth and death certificates records in the Town as well as processing genealogy applications. In addition, the Town Clerk serves the Town Board as the recording secretary of town board meetings (preparing and maintaining the minutes).

Our services include:

**Hunting Licenses:** The office will be open November 1st from 8:00 am - noon to issue the Lottery of NYS DEC DMP's.

**Notary Service:** This free service is available to all town residents, you must appear in person and bring proof of identity to have a document notarized. Visits are available for shut-ins. This service is confidential.

**Medical Loan Closet:** We keep a wide variety of durable medical equipment, including wheel chairs, crutches, shower chairs, and much more. Please call for availability and I will deliver items if needed.

**Sunshine List:** The Town Clerk is a vital link between your local government and you. To strengthen this link, you may sign-up for our Sunshine List by emailing me at [twncrlk@townofwalworthny.gov](mailto:twncrlk@townofwalworthny.gov). You will receive Town Board Minutes, public notices, and other useful information. Connect with your Town by signing up today!
