The Walworth Town Clerk's Office is happy to assist you with the borrowing of these items. Please call for item availability. Items may also be delivered if necessary.

Walworth Food Pantry

Residents who wish to donate goods to the Walworth Food Pantry may do so at the Walworth Town Hall during regular business hours. The following items are in need throughout the year: Cereal, canned fruit, Jell-O, pudding, soup, crackers, canned meats, canned potatoes, rice, jelly, canned vegetables, macaroni, spaghetti sauce, peanut butter, baked beans, coffee, tea bags, and sugar. Other non-food items are also in great need throughout the year. Personal and household items such as bar soap, dish soap, laundry detergent, and bathroom tissue may also be donated.

Hello neighbors! I hope this finds you well. Spring is just around the corner! We are all looking forward to warmer days. Hopefully the winter freeze is nearing it's end.

In January town residents received a mailing notifying you that the Town is conducting a Dog Enumeration (Census). As required by Article 7 of the New York State Agriculture and Walworth Local Law Chapter 56; Any dog(s) 4 months or older must be licensed in the municipality (town) in which that are sheltered in. If you currently own a licensed dog(s) there is no need to do anything. If you have a dog(s) that is not licensed or the license has expired please contact the Town Clerk's Office at (315) 986-1400 ext. 302. Licensing can be done in person, by phone, or by mail with payment in the form of ash, check, or credit card. Failure to respond to the Dog Enumeration could result in a court appearance ticket and possible court time.

I would like to thank those of you who have contacted us regarding your dog license and look forward to hearing from you if you have any questions.

Free Fishing Days:

Each year, the last full weekend in June is designated as Free Fishing Days in New York State. During those two days anyone can fish New York State waters and no license is required. This event started in 1991 to allow people the opportunity to sample the incredible fishing New York State has to offer. Since no license is required, it is the perfect time to take a friend or relative fishing. In 2015, New York State's Free Fishing Days are Saturday and Sunday, June 27th and 28th.

We always encourage feedback, suggestions, and comments from the community regarding department programs and events. Please let us know your experiences!

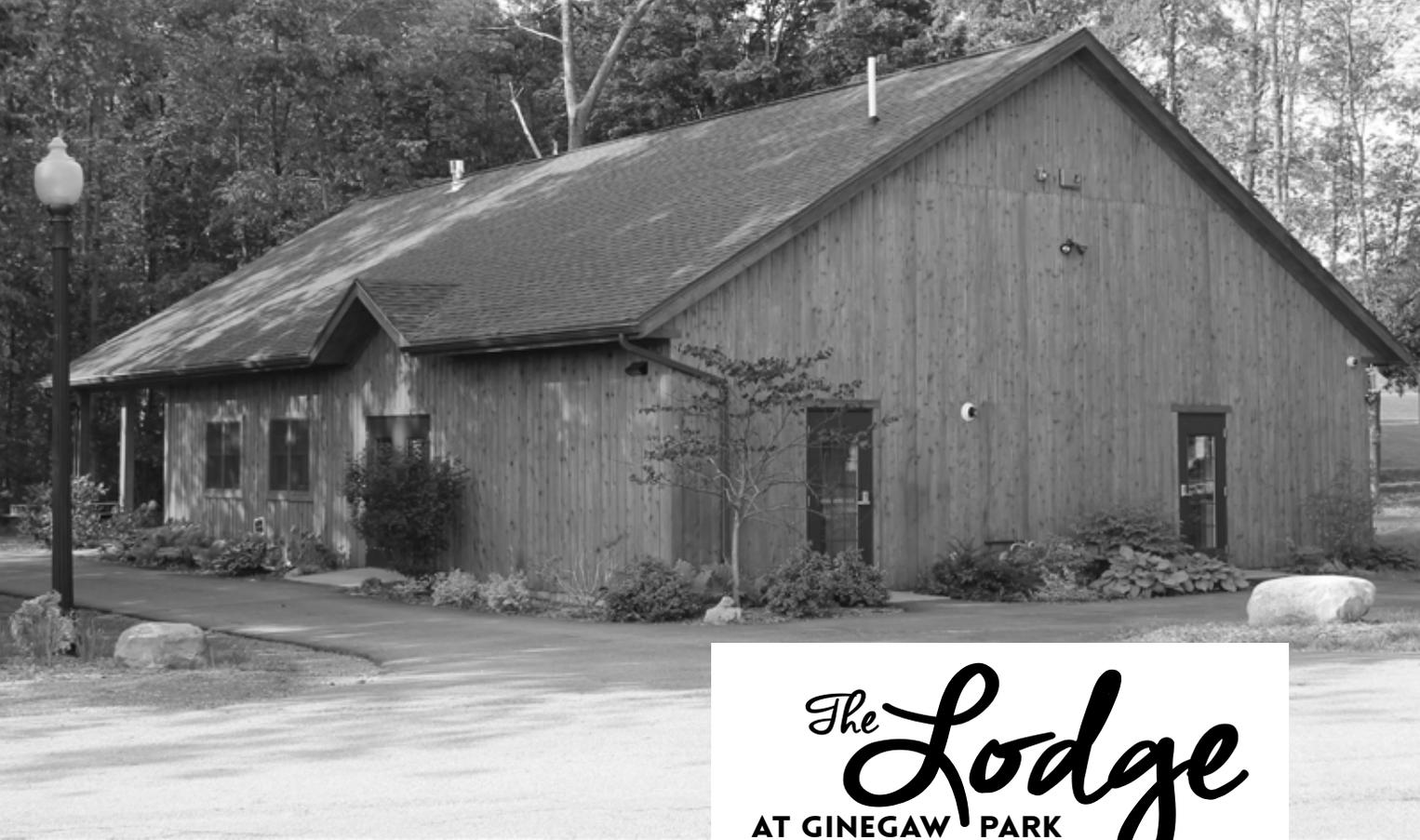

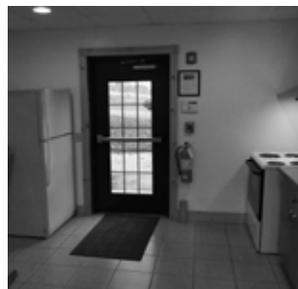


The Lodge

Ginegaw & Sherburne Road PAVILIONS

Alongside the Lodge both the Ginegaw Park and Sherburne Road Park Pavilions offer attractive seasonal (April 1st - October 1st) rental options for parties and events. Each pavilion features seating for up to 80 guests, lights and electricity, outdoor charcoal grills, seamless playground and playing field access, and portable toilets.

GINEGAW PARK PAVILION

Located a stones throw from the Lodge, the Ginegaw Park Pavilion sits adjacent to the park's main playground and remains a favorite rental option for those with children. Other additional amenities include horseshoe pits, nearby access to the Ginegaw Park Hiking Trail, and sewer tied bathrooms within walking distance of the facility.

SHERBURNE ROAD PAVILION

Nestled in the rear of Sherburne Park, Sherburne Road Pavilion offers a unique sense of privacy while still providing top notch rental amenities like our nature themed playground, the popular Red Trail Hiking Loop, playing field access, and more.

RESIDENT RENTAL STATUS

Property taxes must be paid to the Town of Walworth to be considered a resident and be awarded residential rental fees. All other potential renters who do not pay their property taxes to the Town of Walworth are considered non-residents. All facilities are reserved on a first come, first serve basis. Full rental payment is due at the time of reservation. Outdoor pavilion rentals span dawn to dusk. Lodge reservations entitle patrons access to facility from 9:00am-10:00pm on the day of the facility rental.

WHAT IS MS4 and what you, as a homeowner, can do to help!

MS4 is commonly known as “Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems.” The Town of Walworth is mandated by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and The Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) to be included in this program to control stormwater runoff in order to protect and improve the Nation’s waterways. Polluted stormwater runoff is often transported to municipal separate storm sewer systems (MS4s) and ultimately discharged into local rivers and streams without treatment.

This program is intended to improve the Nation’s waterways by reducing the quantity of pollutants that stormwater picks up and carries into storm sewer systems during storm events. Common pollutants include oil and grease from roadways, pesticides from lawns, sediment from construction sites, and carelessly discarded trash, such as cigarette butts, paper wrappers, and plastic bottles. When deposited into nearby waterways through MS4 discharges, these pollutants can impair the waterways, thereby discouraging recreational use of the resource, contaminating drinking water supplies, and interfering with the habitat for fish, other aquatic organisms, and wildlife.

We all live in a watershed. A watershed is a land area that drains into a waterbody, like a creek, river, or lake. Think of a watershed as a series of funnels nested inside each other. For example, when it rains, all the water from a watershed may travel to a creek or waterbody. From there, the creek will flow into a larger stream, which in turn collects water from a larger watershed.

Sources of water pollution like industrial wastes from factories have been greatly reduced in recent years. Now, more than 60% of water pollution comes from things like runoff from homes, excess fertilizer, and pet waste. All these sources add up to a big pollution problem.

So, believe it or not, the biggest source of water pollution today is not industry – it is actually households like yours. But each of us can do small things to help clean up our water. And it starts with realizing that our sewers and storm systems are separate – what goes into storm drains flows directly into the environment, untreated.

Here are some simple tips you can do to help!

- Increase the amount of your yard in tree cover.
- Mulch circles beneath trees and around plant beds.
- Add native plants to your yard. They are low maintenance, tolerate drought, and require no fertilizers or extra watering, thus conserving water and preventing unnecessary pollution.
- Vegetate bare spots in your yard. This helps prevent soil erosion and can beautify your land at the same time. The best way to prevent erosion is by planting shrubs and plants to hold soil in place.
- Use pesticides and fertilizers sparingly. When use is necessary, use these chemicals in the recommended amounts. Avoid application if the forecast calls for rain.
- Sweep up yard debris rather than hosing down areas. Compost or recycle yard waste when possible.
- Don’t overwater your lawn (sewer rates are based on water consumption). Water during the cool times of the day, and don’t let water run off into the storm drain.
- Mow your grass at your mower’s highest setting or at least 3-4”. The roots of your lawn grow as deep as the grass grows tall, so taller grass has deeper, healthier roots, enabling your lawn to better tolerate hot, dry weather. Not spending extra time and money on watering and fertilizing makes your lawn easier and cheaper to maintain. Sharpen your mower blade at least once per summer.

- Your checkbook if your are expecting a refund. We cannot take information off a prior year return or deposit slip.

All counselors are trained to prepare basic returns. If you are unsure if we can prepare your return check the **Out Of Scope** handout available through the Town of Walworth Recreation Department prior to making an appointment.

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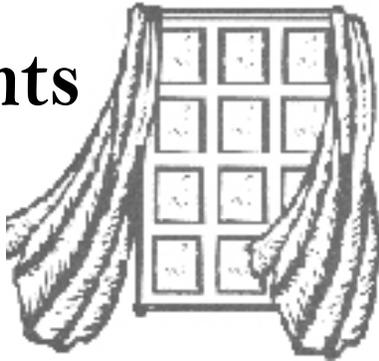

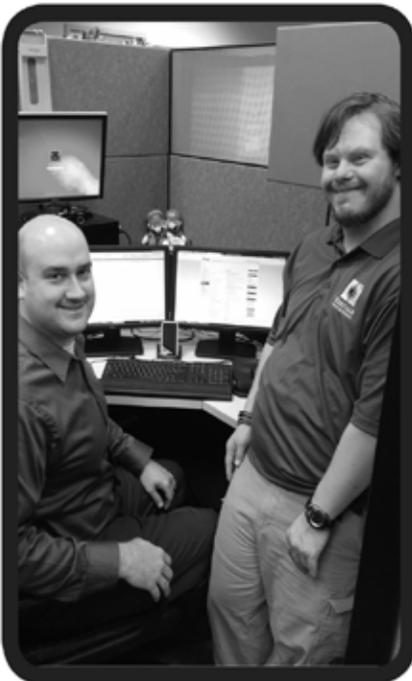

Ice Rink Management & Maintenance:

No two rinks are alike. Setbacks that require additional flooding and maintenance include snowfalls (snow needs to be removed because snow insulates the ice and slows the freezing process) and warm temperatures (thaws soften ice and break down areas that cover low pockets creating weak spots). Daily maintenance includes clearing snow or shavings, repairing gouges and ruts, and putting down more water as time permits.
