Dear Parents,

We would like to extend a warm welcome to you and your family and thank you for participating in our 2015 Travel Softball program. Twilight & Junior Travel Softball participate in the Northern Wayne County Youth Softball League featuring teams from Ontario, Marion, Williamson, Sodus, and North Rose-Wolcott.

The travel season runs from the first week in May through the third week in June. All home games will be played primarily at the softball field at Sherburne Road Park. If both Twilights and Juniors are scheduled for the same day Twilights will play home games on Diamond #2 in Ginegaw. Teams will begin practicing prior to the season and will continue to practice through the season on off nights and occasion Saturdays.

All practice/game nights for both levels will be Mondays & Wednesdays. Both levels will play occasional Saturday games. Games begin at 6:05pm on weeknights and 10:00am on Saturdays (though there are some Saturday exceptions). Some important things to remember for the upcoming travel season:

- ❖ Saturday, May 2nd: Picture Day & Walworth Recreation's 8th Annual Opening Day Celebration (Individual and team pictures are taken in the morning, our hot dog roast and baseball festivities begin at noon)
